

Course-Workshop Regulations of the National System of Statistical and Geographic Information, SNIEG

Introduction:

The National Institute of Statistics and Geography of Mexico (INEGI), within the framework of the attributions assigned to it by the Law of the National Statistical and Geographical Information System (LSNIEG) in Article 36, promotes a training and updating program for public servants that participate in the National Statistical and Geographical Information System (SNIEG), on the regulatory provisions that are registered in the Normative Compilation System on the SNIEG web site (<https://snieg.mx/default.aspx>) and the knowledge of the System itself, in order to disseminate and provide the necessary tools for its proper application.

One of those training topics that INEGI makes available to public servants is the course "The SNIEG Regulations", in its online mode, based on the basic contents of the Rules to establish the Regulations of the National Statistical Information System and Geographical, which describes aspects of interest on historical background, development and repercussions regarding the proper use of the current Regulations of the National System of Statistical and Geographical Information of Mexico.

Objective:

At the end of the course, the participants will identify the importance of the regulations in the national statistical and geographic systems and in particular in the National System of Statistical and Geographic Information (SNIEG), the different types of SNIEG Regulations, their scope of application, and they will describe the procedure for the elaboration of proposals of normative dispositions, by means of the revision of the current regulations, in order to facilitate their participation in the generation of statistical and geographic information of interest to the SNIEG.

Contents:

The course is divided into five units:

1. Background.
2. The regulations in the official national statistical and geographic information systems.
3. The regulations within the framework of the National System of Statistical and Geographic Information.
4. The Rules to establish the Regulations of the National System of Statistical and Geographic Information.
5. The current and historical Regulations in the SNIEG.

Online mode:

There is an online version of the course, for which the interested party is provided with a link to the course, their username and password so that they can have access to the content, evaluations and other materials.

Duration:

The course lasts 20 hours and the estimated time of daily dedication is two hours.

Learning activities:

Some tasks and exercises are requested, as well as the resolution of evaluations.

Participant profile:

Personnel of the State Units that carry out statistical and geographical activities within the framework of the SNIEG.

Participant role:

The participant is responsible for complying with the agenda by assigning the times that are most convenient for him to review the contents, resolve the evaluations that the course consists of, as well as express his doubts.

Evaluation:

Assessments distributed throughout the course are included. All of them prioritize the practical aspect of what has been learned.

The final grade will be obtained from the weighted average of the partial evaluations, where the minimum passing grade is 6.0.

Intercommunication:

The course has an online chat, as well as a form for the participant to express doubts or comments and a document in which they can find out the most Frequently Asked Questions.

Recognition document:

At the end of the course, a certificate of participation issued by INEGI-SNIEG is delivered to the participant via email.

Technical requirements:

The participant must have computer equipment with:

- Intel Pentium 4 or later processor supporting SSE2
- 2 Gb RAM
- 5mbps internet connection
- Updated browser (Chrome recommended)
